

Buckeye Water Conservation and Drainage District Construction Water Contract Requirements

Prior to receiving construction water from District's facilities, you will need to complete the following requirements by Buckeye Water Conservation and Drainage District:

- Meet with District Supervisor &/or Manager to discuss;
 - Project Location
 - Estimated Amount Required
 - Estimated Duration of Project
 - Estimated Daily/Weekly Demand
 - District Water Availability
 - Possible Location for Pump(**must be metered**)
 - Pad Requirements at Pad (for erosion control)
- Obtain a signed construction water sales contract from the District
 - Water Rate is \$3 per 1,000 Gallon
 - Administration Fee based on Contract Demand/Duration
- Establish an account with BWCDD for water sales and 100% funding (based on estimated usage) and Administration Fee prior to obtaining water.
- Proof of General Liability Insurance in the amount of at least \$2,000,000 aggregate with Buckeye Water Conservation and Drainage District as “named insured.”
- Proof of metering on all pumps for recording withdrawal amounts, pursuant to A.R.S. 45-604, to be provided to the BWCDD for calculating payment purposes

Prior to receiving construction water you will need to complete the following items:

- Establish water usage reporting method with District (e.g. daily/weekly/monthly)
- Meet with District Supervisor &/or Manager to verify pump and pad requirements are met
